

VISTA POP WARNER POLICIES

Please read and initial each statement after you have read and understand them. Complete the legal signature at the end. No document modifications are allowed.

I, _____ am the Parent and/or Legal Guardian of _____, the participant in VPW.

_____ I understand by June 30th a complete copy of the report card for the entire school year and/or 4th quarter report card must be turned in to VPW or the participant will not be able to receive equipment. The participant will also not be allowed to take part in practice until all documents are received and verified. No exceptions will be allowed or granted.

_____ I understand that by June 30th a completed Physical Examination Form must be turned in to VPW or the participant will not be able to receive equipment. The participant will also not be allowed to take part in practice until all documents are received and verified. No exceptions will be allowed or granted. The only form allowed is the **current years'** Physical Form. No other forms are allowed. The form can be downloaded from our website, www.vistapopwarner.com.

_____ I understand that I will be asked to work volunteer time to support the operations of the program. The Snack Bar Manager & Field Manager will determine the shift dates and times that need support by your participant's team. Failure to not show up for a scheduled team assignment may result in the deduction of funds from your participant's team's account.

_____ I understand the refund policy for Vista Pop Warner is as follows for football. There are no full refunds after June 30th, no refund for the \$25 late registration fee and there is a \$20 non refundable processing fee. A football participant has until the first Saturday of practice in August to drop out of VPW and receive a refund of half the registration fees. A request in writing to drop from the program must be submitted to the President or Vice President of VPW on time with all equipment returned. Equipment includes helmet, chin strap, pants, game pants, 7 piece pad set and shoulder pads. Failure to drop prior to the first Friday of practice in August or turn in the required equipment will result in no refund and your fees will be considered a donation to VPW. Refund example: At registration you paid \$365 to register. After June 30th you will receive a refund of \$162.50 (\$20 processing fee deducted).

_____ I understand the refund policy for Vista Pop Warner is as follows for Cheer. A cheer participant has until cheer fittings, when uniforms and camp gear is ordered to drop from the VPW cheer program. After uniforms are ordered any drops from VPW will result in no refund. A request in writing to drop the participant from the program must be submitted on time to the President or Cheer Coordinator of VPW. The \$25 late registration fee is not refundable and considered a donation to VPW. There is a \$20 non refundable processing fee.

_____ I understand that no dogs are allowed at the practice or game fields at any time. This rule is based on the rules of the Vista Unified School district.

_____ I understand at the time of football equipment issue I will give a credit card and/or cash deposit of \$250 to Vista Pop Warner. At the time of exiting the VPW program either after dropping or the end of the season I understand that I must return the helmet, chin strap, pants, game pants, 7 piece pad set and shoulder pads issued to the participant before my equipment deposit is returned. If I fail to timely return the equipment, I also understand that my account will be charged the \$250 or I forfeit the cash deposit.

_____ I understand that my child is not guaranteed a team, coach or division. This will be decided by the Draft Committee. My child will be placed according to what is in the best interest and safest for the child and association. In addition, participants are not guaranteed they will "track" with their previous team or coach.

_____ I will support the method and result of the team draft within the association and/or conference and understand that the decision of my child's placement on a team is final. Furthermore, I understand that VPW will attempt to place the participants in the lowest possible division.

_____ I understand that my child must attend a mandatory player evaluation for all tackle football players. The date/s, times and location will be posted at www.vistapopwarner.com.

_____ I understand that if I owe a balance of monies to VPW from the current or past seasons my child will not be allowed to start the current season until all balances are paid in full. This includes, but is not limited to, scholarships, prior fundraisers, outstanding equipment and payment plans.

_____ I understand that I cannot use the Vista Pop Warner Tax ID number without the VPW Board of Directors knowledge and approval.

_____ I understand that any and all monies with regard to the team my child is on will be turned in to the treasurer of VPW only. This includes any donations, individual team fundraising, spirit packs, etc.

_____ I understand that I will not enter into any contracts on behalf of Vista Pop Warner without the consent of the Board of Directors. Any contracts entered into without VPW Board approval will be my responsibility and not that of VPW.

_____ I understand that my child's age and weight determine what division they play in. Vista Pop Warner supports no improper dieting and/or weight loss. My child might have to be moved due to their weight after practice has started, but prior to Mandatory Weight Certification, Tackle Players Only.

Each Pop Warner participant is required to submit these documents for certification. Certification is a process that is required and administered by National Pop Warner. No exceptions can or will be made.
